LEAD-Nigeria, within **LEAD-Anglophone West Africa**, is a Member Programme of **LEAD International**, a global non-profit organization with a fast growing network of over 2,000 leaders and professionals in over 80 countries, who are inspired and committed to achieving leadership and good governance for a sustainable world. **LEAD-Nigeria is hosted by the Foundation for Environmental Development and Education in Nigeria, (FEDEN)** situated at **No. 8, Thorburn Avenue, Yaba, Lagos, Nigeria.**

The **LEAD Africa** Fellowship Programme is a capacity development programme jointly initiated by **LEAD International**, **LEAD Africa**, and in partnership with the Shell Foundation. The program commits to contribute to enhancing the capacities of emerging, high-growth potential leaders, for the achievement of sustainable development in Africa.

Applications are now invited from suitably qualified candidates to participate in the year 2010 **LEAD Africa** Fellowship Programme. The Programme covers 2 one-week training sessions at national and regional levels, with a further Pan African session, and a final international session, between April and November 2010. On successful completion of the fellowship training, participants are admitted into the prestigious global network of **LEAD** Fellows.

WHO SHOULD APPLY

Prospective applicants for the **LEAD Africa** Fellowship Programme should exhibit a high degree of proven commitment to achieving change through social entrepreneurship, and impactful leadership that will bring about sustainable development. Female candidates are strongly encouraged to apply.

In addition, the following requirements apply:

- * Age 25-45yrs. Should be resident in Nigeria;
- * University graduate, with at least two years work experience in the public, private or non-governmental sectors;
- * Exposure to multi-disciplinary and multi-cultural environment is useful;
- * Demonstrable leadership capacity;
- * High level of written and spoken English;
- * Versatility in, or strong potential for social networking via Facebook, Twitter, Ning etc to facilitate e-learning;
- * Written commitment of release for the training from employers;
- * Two references.

COURSE FEE

Appropriate fees apply. However, limited opportunities exist for partial scholarships of about 80% of the training fees, awarded on merit, and on a competitive basis. Full details will be contained in the final letter of admission.
